Group Touring Experience | Classic Tour

The Classic Tour is a family-friendly, self-guided tour of the Midwest’s most-visited house museum. See the mansion’s most famous rooms like the Breakfast Room (Green Room), Living Room, and Library. The Classic Tour is a self-guided experience of the lower level, first, and second floors, great for group tours of all types. Includes Grounds Admission.

Treasure Books for Children

School groups with grades K-5 students have the opportunity to receive free, individual treasure books to enhance the Classic Tour. The book is a treasure hunt style booklet to engage children throughout the mansion. If this would be a fitting addition to your group, please let the Glensheen group tour organizer know in advance to ensure the booklets will be ready for your group upon arrival.

Group Arrival at Glensheen

- All guests—both general public and group members—will be welcomed at the Carriage House ticketing area.
- To maintain a safe touring experience, upon arrival all guests will form a single line through the Carriage House. This single entry line allows for guests entering the estate to be spaced out in accordance with state mandated, reduced building capacities.
- To prepare, group members are requested to break down into smaller pods of approximately 3-5 people per pod. Each pod will then wait in a line separated 6 feet from other pods. The pods will proceed through the Carriage House and then enter the Mansion. Entry into the Mansion is spaced out by approximately 3 minutes per pod.
- Student groups, grades K-5, will receive free treasure books from ticketing upon arrival.

While Touring the Mansion

- Have a question? Ask us anything. Our staff is here to enhance your touring experience and to help protect the museum. In the unlikely event of a disruption, staff has the right to escort individuals off the property.
- Celebrate Preservation - Please refrain from touching anything in the mansion. The entire house is historic, so we ask that you also keep a safe distance from furnishings, walls, and display cases.
- Food & Drink - Food, beverages (other than resealable water), and gum are not allowed in the mansion. They are, however, allowed on the grounds, and we encourage guests to bring a picnic lunch for a lakeside meal.
- Photography - Non-flash photography is encouraged. Photography and filming may be unavailable in some areas.
- Personal items such as strollers and backpacks are not allowed in the mansion.
- Teachers and chaperones are responsible for the behavior of the group's members.

While Touring the Outdoors

- Have a question? Ask us anything. Our staff is here to enhance your touring experience and to help protect the museum. In the unlikely event of a disruption, staff has the right to escort individuals off the property.
- Plantings & Gardens - Please refrain from touching any plants on the property that are in the gardens and along the pathways. We ask that you respect the gardens and take pictures of what you find lovely.

- Food & Drink - We encourage guests to bring a picnic lunch for a lakeside meal. Just remember to pack in and pack out. We provide trash, compost and recycling receptacles.

The Glensheen App

Glensheen has a free app available in the app store called "Glensheen". This app contains an audio tour, a map, and additional information to enhance your self-guided Classic Tour or Grounds Admission experience.

Accessibility

The grounds, lower level and first floor of the mansion are accessible by persons who are mobility impaired. The second floor is not accessible; a video is available to watch on an iPad. A two weeks notice is required to make special arrangements for the visually or hearing impaired.

Approximate Timing

Due to reduced building capacities, a specific entry time is unable to be reserved for groups. It is anticipated that groups of up to 60 people may expect to spend 2.5 - 3 hours at Glensheen. **Please note that this time frame is not a guarantee.** Days with increased visitation may extend the amount of time a group spends at Glensheen. State-mandated restrictions may also impact time frames.

Payments

- Lump Sum: If a group would like to pay with one lump sum, please ensure the group leader is first in line through the Carriage House ticketing queue. Wrist bands for group members will be distributed at the time of payment.
- Advanced Payment: Groups may pay in advance. Please note, advanced payment is not a guarantee of a specific entry time to Glensheen. Wristbands for group members will be distributed by ticketing prior to starting the mansion tour.
